Mr. Christian Phillips, DM MRCOG
Consultant Gynaecologist, Hampshire Hospitals, Basingstoke.

Christian is a consultant gynaecologist in Basingstoke. He has a special interest in minimally invasive procedures for pelvic floor reconstruction. He has a DM thesis in pelvic floor connective tissue disorders and maintains his interest in research. Christian has been invited to speak nationally and internationally in the field of urogynaecology and pelvic floor reconstruction. He is the chair of the Southern and Wessex urogynaecology network and the regional preceptor for the urogynaecology and benign vaginal surgery Advanced Training Specialist Module. He has written numerous books, chapters and papers and is a peer reviewer for the International Urogynaecology Journal.



Mr. Tim Sayer, MD FRCOG
Consultant Gynaecologist, Hampshire Hospitals, Basingstoke.

Tim is a consultant gynaecologist in Basingstoke. He has a special interest in urogynaecology and lectures nationally and internationally in pelvic floor reconstruction. He has a special expertise in the vaginal mesh repairs and laparoscopic surgery. Tim has been involved in numerous research studies including the multicentre trial of the PROSIMA mesh repair and MRC laparoscopic versus open colposuspension. Tim continues to lecture throughout the world on vaginal mesh repairs.



Mr. Arcot Venkatasubramaniam, MBBS FRCSEd
Consultant Colorectal Surgeon, Hampshire Hospitals, Basingstoke.

Arcot is a consultant colorectal surgeon at Basingstoke. He has extensive laparoscopic colorectal interests and is a national trainer in laparoscopic surgery and hosts a masterclass on laparoscopic hernia repair and laparoscopic ventral mesh rectopexy. He also has a special interest in pelvic floor conditions, including faecal incontinence and ano-rectal dysfunction.



Mr. Simon Jackson, MD FRCOG
Consultant Gynaecologist and Urogynaecologist, Oxford.

Simon is a consultant in Oxford specializing in urogynaecology and laparoscopic surgery. Since becoming a consultant he has developed laparoscopic pelvic floor reconstructive surgery, offering uterine preserving surgery. He has published over 70 papers on urinary incontinence and prolapse and has written several textbooks. He is the director of Oxford's urogynaecology subspecialty training programme and is a member of the Subspecialty Training Committee at the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists.



Miss Natalia Price, MD MRCOG
Consultant Obstetrician and Gynaecologist, Subspecialist in Urogynaecology, Oxford.

Natalia is a Consultant in Oxford. The main focus of her work is minimal access surgical techniques to treat a wide range of gynaecological problems, including menstrual disorders, fibroids, ovarian cysts, prolapse and incontinence. She maintains a strong interest in academic research and has already published more than 30 peer-reviewed papers and book chapters. Her current research is a prospective study comparing laparoscopic hysteropexy with vaginal hysterectomy. She performs the annual evidence update for the National Library for Health on management of urinary incontinence and prolapse.



Mr. Anthony Smith, MD FRCOG
Consultant Gynaecologist and Urogynaecologist, Manchester.

Tony has been head of the Regional department of Urogynaecology at St Mary's Hospital, Manchester for the last 18 years. He has continued with his research and clinical interest in the causes and treatment of pelvic organ prolapse and urinary incontinence in women. He has published his research and surgical experience in journals and textbooks. Tony has pioneered laparoscopic techniques (key hole surgery) for the treatment of stress incontinence and prolapse and has demonstrated and lectured on this surgery in many countries. He has written over thirty chapters in gynaecology textbooks particularly concerning laparoscopic techniques in urogynaecology and has been President of both BSGE and BSUG.
